PFOC – "Português para falantes de outras lenguas" Description of the modality of adult education

- The aims of the modality are that foreigners who are living in Portugal can learn Portuguese, they can relate with other people and they have more posibilities to find a job in Portugal.

- The structure of the course has four parts: 75 hours of al course, exam A1, 75 hours A2 course, exam A2.

- 6 units with 25 hours each unit.

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Description of classroom activities

- The age of students is different, there are 2 groups: the first around 70 years and another around 25 years.

- They have mode exercises of pronunciation, increased their vocabulary, practiced the construction of sentences and the conversations of daily life.
